


Welcome!

We are so excited for you to join us at Dufferin Grove Park for The Disability Artisan Market! Below is some helpful information about the Market to help prepare you for your visit.

Getting Here

Dufferin Grove Park is located in Toronto, Ontario, at 875 Dufferin Street, just south of Dufferin Street and Bloor Street West, right across from the Dufferin Mall. The Market will be at the south west corner of the park, just north of Sylvan Avenue.

Subway



Take the Bloor line to Dufferin Station and walk about 7 minutes or 500 meters south down Dufferin Street towards Dufferin Mall.The park will be on your left. For paved paths and to avoid stairs, walk to the south entrance of the park at Sylvan Avenue. Alternatively, you can turn left onto Bloor Street West and turn right on Gladstone Avenue to enter the park from the north end.



Bus

Take the 29 or the 929 Dufferin bus to Sylvan Avenue. The Market will be located on the south west end of the park right off of Sylvan Avenue.



Streetcar

Take the College streetcar east or west, getting off at Dufferin Street. Walk north on Dufferin Street for about 5 minutes or 400 meters and the Market will be on your right at the south west end of Dufferin Grove Park, just off Sylvan Avenue.

Wheel-Trans / Taxi

The Market is located at the south west end of Dufferin Grove Park just off Sylvan Avenue. There is a small parking lot with plenty of room for a drop-off on Sylvan Avenue and a paved, accessible entrance to the Market. Request a drop off at 30 Sylvan Avenue or at Sylvan Avenue and Gladstone Avenue.



Parking

There is paid underground parking at Dufferin Mall just across the street from the Market. Alternatively, there is a Green P just southwest at 123 Bonar Place or limited street parking throughout the neighbourhood.

Arriving

The Market will be at the south west end of Dufferin Grove Park. Each booth will be accessible by paved paths that will run through the centre of the market. To avoid any unpaved routes or steps within the park, enter from the north end of the park on Gladstone Avenue off Bloor Street West and head south, or from the south end of the park off Sylvan Avenue.

Arriving


This is what the park looks like if you are coming north from College Street. Turn right onto this street for an accessible access point.

Arriving

This is what the park looks like if you are coming south from Dufferin Station. This is the first pathway into the park; however, to avoid stairs, continue south to the Sylvan Avenue entrance.

Accessible North Entrance


If you are coming from Dufferin Station and require a fully paved, step-free path through the park, turn left on Bloor Street West and right on Gladstone Avenue to enter the park, and travel south to the Market using the path pictured below.

Accessible South Entrance

If you are coming from College Street or if you prefer to travel to the south end of the park via Dufferin Street, the Sylvan Avenue entrance is the main accessible entrance to the Market pictured below and is the perfect place for drop offs and pick ups.

The Market

When you enter the Market, there will be an information table with a volunteer who will be happy to answer any of your questions, or help you find whatever you may seek! Along the paved paths will be tables of vendors selling home made artisanal goods, music, community activities and food and drinks!

Washrooms

There are outhouses located between the two paths that make up the Market. They are single-stall outhouses and are located across a small patch of grass off the main path.

Washrooms


On the northeast end of the park, there are gendered washrooms in a small brick building pictured below. The women's washroom is on the north side of the building and the men's is on the south. The doors will be propped open and there are accessible stalls; however, you must travel over grass to access these washrooms off the main path.

Accessible Washrooms

There are accessible washrooms located in Dufferin Mall, just across the street from the Market. Head north on Dufferin Street to the stoplights and cross towards Marshalls.

Enter into the mall through the doors pictured below.



Turn left heading into Marshalls. Turn right past the checkout area, and turn left into the elevator entrance pictured below.

Follow the path to the elevators located on the left.



Exit the elevators into the mall and follow the signs for the washrooms, or head towards the food court.



Turn left into the food court and follow the circle towards the washrooms that will be on the left.



There are no doorways and an accessible stall with grab bars in both gendered washrooms. The men's will be on the left and the women's on the right.
