




Welcome!

We are so excited for you to join us at Glad Day Bookshop for Crip Café! Below is some helpful information about the venue to help prepare you for your visit.

GETTING HERE

Glad Day Bookshop is located in Toronto, Ontario at 499 Church Street. The closest major intersection is Wellesley Street and Church Street.

Subway

Take Line 1 to Wellesley Station. The venue is about 300 meters or a 3-minute walk east from the station on Wellesley Street. Once you reach Church Street, simply cross to the east side of the street, head south, and Glad Day will be on your left.

Bus



Take the 94 Wellesley Bus to Wellesley Station. The venue is about 300 meters or a 3-minute walk east from the station on Wellesley Street. Once you reach Church Street, simply cross to the east side of the street, head south, and Glad Day will be on your left.



Streetcar

Take the 506 Carlton streetcar to Church Street. Get off at Church Street, and walk 400 meters or for about 6 minutes north on Church Street. Glad Day is on the east side of the street just north of Maitland Street.



Taxi

Glad Day Bookshop is located in Toronto, Ontario at 499 Church Street. A drop-off in front of the venue is absolutely doable; however, the nearest curb cut is a little bit north of the venue at Church Street and Wellesley Street.

Parking

There is no parking on-site; however, there is limited metered parking on nearby side streets and a paid parking garage at 540 Church Street just 90 meters south of the venue on the west side of Church Street.

ENTERING


There is one entrance to Glad Day Bookshop directly on Church Street. This is a step-free entrance and there is a push-to-open button; however, it is currently out of service, and if it remains so, we will have a staff member at the door to assist patrons.

THE VENUE


This venue is a bookshop and café/bar! Upon entering, a box office table will be set up directly in front of you where you will check in. Further into the venue, there will be chairs and a few tables set up for the audience, leading to the stage in the back left corner. To the right is the bar where you can order snacks and drinks that can be consumed at any point during the evening.

THE VENUE


This is the space from the opposite end! From here, the stage will be to your right and the washrooms will be directly behind you.





ACCESSIBLE WASHROOM


The accessible washroom is located past the bar and to the left. For additional washrooms, continue down the hallway and down two flights of stairs.

ACCESSIBLE WASHROOM

This is the step-free washroom on the main level of Glad Day. This washroom has grab bars, but unfortunately does not have a push-to-open button or any sort of emergency button or pull cord.





WASHROOMS

If you continue down the hallway, you will come to this small flight five steps up. At the end of the hallway, you will turn left to head down two additional flights of stairs to access the other washrooms.

At the bottom of the stairs to the left is a single-person washroom with a toilet, and to the right is a single-person washroom with a urinal and a toilet. There are photos of each on the next page.
